

Re-Entry Policy

1. If crack and crevice treating the interior of a home where elderly, children under Kindergarten age, people with breathing problems, or pregnant women, the home must be vacant for a minimum of 30 minutes.
 - a. If there are exotic pets, (fish, birds, reptiles) either do not treat in those rooms, or they must be out for 3 hours. If fish are present, the tanks must be covered with a towel and the filter unplugged for a minimum of 30 minutes after treatment.
 - b. If typical household pets are present (dogs/cats), they must be kept in a room that is not treated for a minimum of 30 minutes.
2. If fogging any areas (attics, crawlspaces, vacant rooms), no people or pets can be inside the structure for 2 hours after treatment is finished. Fish tanks must be covered with a towel and the filter unplugged. If upon returning, there is a strong chemical smell, open doors and windows and ventilate until smell subsides.
3. If treating a home for fleas, all people and pets must be out for 2 hours after treatment is finished. Fish tanks need to be covered with a towel and the filter unplugged.

Cockroaches, Crickets, Earwigs, Firebrats, Silverfish, and Spiders: Apply as a course, low pressure spray to areas where these pests hide, such as baseboards, corners, storage areas, closets, around water pipes, doors and windows, attics and eaves, cabinets, behind and under refrigerators, sinks, furnaces and stoves, the underside of shelves, drawers and similar areas.
