FRUIT, NUT, AVOCADO Make first feeding in the late winter or early spring after new growth starts. Second feeding should be made about the first of summer; the third in late summer. VEGETABLES:	evenly broadcast 0.75 lb per 100 sq ft of cultivated area. WATER THOROUGHLY AFTER APPLICATION.
ROSES, FLOWERING SHRUBS & EVERGREENS:	Water well the day before feeding. Sprinkle 0.25 cup evenly around base of plant and work lightly into top 1 in. of soil. Water thoroughly. Use every six weeks throughout growing season. New Plantings: Work 0.25 cup into soil at bottom of hole before planting. WATER THOROUGHLY.
