Mix 3 Parts Water... **16oz./1 PINT** ...to 1 Part MAX

**DIRECTIONS**

**No Direct Sunlight**

- FIRST PROTECT** Bird droppings may not look threatening but they are animal excrement. Wear proper PPE (Personal Protective Equipment) such as coveralls, gloves, respirators, eye protection and face masks.
- ASSESS JOB** Perform initial removal of all loose waste (droppings, nesting materials). During the sweeping, scooping or shoveling, moisten waste to keep it from becoming airborne.
- MIX RATIO 3:1** Use an empty spray bottle & fill it with three parts water & one part Dissolve-It MAX.
- DEEPLY SOAK** Thoroughly soak the remaining hardened bird droppings. The enzymes contained within Dissolve-It will start softening the biological waste.
- WAIT 20 MINUTES** Time needed will depend on the amount of waste remaining after step 2. As the product starts to work, the waste will begin to soften.
- KEEP WET** Keep the treated waste moist at all times during the 20 minute wait. Enzymes multiply faster in a moist environment speeding up the rate of biodegradation. Heavier and older droppings may take longer than 20 minutes.
- CLEAN UP** When the waste has reached a softened state, scrub with a hard nylon brush and rinse away with water. A pressure washer may be helpful on large heavily soiled jobs. In some cases it may be necessary to reapply Dissolve-It.
- FINISHING** After the waste is sprayed away, spot-clean any tough spots. Get everything up.
- END TRACES** To boost the efficacy of the entire project, we recommend a final misting (using a spray bottle) of diluted household bleach at a ratio of about 10 parts water to 1 part bleach. This will remove all trace elements that returning birds can sense. Don't rinse the bleach, just let it dry before applying the bird deterrent product.
