# PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

## HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS

**CAUTION:** Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco, or using the toilet. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse.

### PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT (PPE)

Applicators and other handlers, must wear the following:

- Long-sleeved shirt • Long pants • Shoes plus socks • Gloves

### USER SAFETY REQUIREMENTS:

- Users should remove clothing/PPE immediately if pesticide gets inside. Then wash thoroughly and put on clean clothing.
- Follow manufacturer's instructions for cleaning/maintaining PPE. If there are no such instructions for washables, use detergent and hot water. Keep and wash PPE separately from other laundry.

### PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Do not use on electrical equipment or on surfaces that can be harmed or stained by water.

## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

### USE RESTRICTIONS

- Do not enter or allow others to enter until vapors, mists and aerosols have dispersed, sprays have dried and the treated area has been thoroughly ventilated.
- Do not apply this product in a way that will contact workers or other persons, either directly or through drift. Only protected handlers may be in the area during applications.
- Do not remain in treated area. Exit area immediately and remain outside the treated area until aerosols, vapors, and/or mist have dispersed.
- Do not apply as a broadcast treatment to indoor surfaces at residential sites, including nurseries, day care centers, schools, hospitals, and nursing homes.
- For articles: Do not wet articles to point of runoff or drip. Do not use treated article until spray has dried.
- Remove pets, birds and cover any water inhabited by fish (such as aquariums and ornamental fish ponds) before application. Turn off aquarium filtering systems before spraying and wait approximately 15 minutes after application before turning the filter back on.
- Application is prohibited directly into sewers or drains, or to any area like a gutter where drainage to sewers, storm drains, water bodies, or aquatic habitat can occur. Do not allow the product to enter any drain during or after application.
- Not for use in outdoor residential mosquito misting systems.
- Application as a surface spray, crack and crevice or spot spray: Remove or cover exposed food and water before application. Remove or cover dishes, utensils, food processing equipment and food preparation surfaces or wash them thoroughly before use. Do not apply more than 1 time per day.
- In the home, cover all dishes, utensils, food processing surfaces and equipment during treatment or thoroughly wash before use.
- Do not use in food areas of food handling establishments, restaurants, or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas where food is exposed or facility is in operation. Serving areas are areas where prepared foods are served, such as dining rooms, but excluding areas where foods may be prepared or held.
- May be applied in non-food/feed areas. Non-food/feed establishment areas are areas such as garbage rooms, lavatories, entries and vestibules, offices, locker rooms, machine rooms, boiler rooms, mop closets and storage (after canning or bottling).
- Commercial food/feed areas where the product cannot be used include areas for receiving, serving, storage (Dry, Cold, Frozen, Raw), packaging (Cleaning, Slicing, Cooking, Grinding), edible waste storage, enclosed processing systems (Mills, Dairies, Edible Oils, Syrups).

- Do not use in aircraft.

### SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING

Unless otherwise noted, hold container upright and spray from a distance of 12 to 15 inches.

When treating surfaces and fabrics where water alone could stain, spray in an inconspicuous area to test for possible staining or discoloration.

### INDOORS:

**Cockroaches, Silverfish, Crickets, Scorpions and Spiders:** Spray into hiding places such as cracks and crevices, behind sinks, cabinets, along baseboards and floors, around drains and plumbing, hitting insects with spray whenever possible.

**Ants:** Spray trails, nests and points of entry. Spray on ants where possible.

**TO KILL Bed Bugs:** Apply as a spot treatment to cracks and crevices, around baseboards, floorboards, bed boards and walls. First, thoroughly clean and air mattresses and springs. Then spot treat only areas that may harbor bed bugs, concentrating on tufts, folds and seams. Allow treated articles to thoroughly dry before use. Repeat after 4 weeks if necessary. **To treat beds:** Disassemble the bed frame and remove bedding. Do not apply to bedding. Wash bedding and dry using high heat to kill bed bugs. Apply this product to the bed frame, mattress and box spring. Application to mattresses and box springs is for treatment of seams, edges and tufts only. Do not saturate the mattress or box spring. Do not treat the entire surface of the bed or spring. Allow the spray to dry before using the mattress and/or box spring. Also apply the product to cracks and crevices in sleeping area. Make spot treatment to baseboards, behind pictures/wall hangings, along and underneath carpet edges and to other infested articles/furniture in the bedroom or sleeping area. Do not apply to stuffed animals or toys.

**To treat luggage:** Remove contents and spot treat areas that may harbor bed bugs, concentrating on corners, pockets and seams.

**Fleas & Ticks (Adults and Larvae):** Remove and thoroughly clean or destroy pet bedding. Spray pet sleeping quarters and bed then spot treat floor and floor covering, with special attention to cracks and crevices around baseboards, window and door frames. Place fresh bedding in animal quarters following treatment. Allow to dry thoroughly before allowing pets to contact treated areas. Do not retreat in less than 60 days.

**TO KILL Dust Mites:** This product controls house dust mites that may cause asthma, hay fever, rhinitis, watery eyes and sneezing. **On Upholstered Furniture and Drapes** - test fabric in an inconspicuous area to insure dyes will not bleed. Apply as a spot, crack & crevice treatment to fabric surfaces paying particular attention to tufts and seams. Spray until damp. Do not use on delicate fabrics. Allow furniture to dry thoroughly before using.

**On Carpets** - DO NOT APPLY AS A BROADCAST SPRAY AT RESIDENTIAL SITES, in these sites apply only as a spot, crack & crevice treatment. Use an overlapping pattern to insure total coverage. After application, brush the surface of the carpet with a broom or brush to insure deep penetration. Allow carpet to dry thoroughly before reentering the treated area. Drying time can be accelerated by using a fan. Leave room while fan is in use until carpet is dry. **On Mattresses** - spray the sides of mattresses until damp, paying particular attention to tufts and seams. Allow to dry thoroughly before using.

## STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

**Pesticide Storage:** Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or open flame. Do not transport or store below 32°F. Protect from freezing.

**Pesticide Disposal:** As a responsible environmental practice, where possible, it is recommended that all of the contents of the container be used, carefully following label directions and precautions. If wastes cannot be avoided, follow if partly filled instructions below.

**Container Handling:** Non-refillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. If empty: Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. If partly filled: Call your local solid waste agency for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.
