APPLICATION DIRECTIONS

1. Clean debris.
2. Cut nozzle to desired bead size.
3. Pierce inner foil and insert cartridge into caulking gun.
4. Hold at 45° angle and apply by pushing sealant ahead of nozzle to achieve a smooth seal.
5. Press substrates together firmly.
