DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

TANK MIX: Add appropriate amount of TankMax to spray tank solution prior to the addition of pesticides and fertilizers.

PALE YELLOW: pH = 7.0 • **ORANGE:** pH = 6.0-6.5
RED: pH = 4.5-5.0 (Optimal pH range for alkaline hydrolysis prevention = 5.0-6.0)

USE RATES: The typical rate for TankMax is 4-8 oz. per 100 gallons of water.

TankMax is a spray tank acidifying agent capable of reducing tank pH levels to prevent alkaline hydrolysis (the chemical degradation of pesticides at a higher pH). As TankMax lowers the pH of the spray solution, the solution will change colors from pale yellow to red indicating optimal solution pH has been reached.
